

Are you worried about someone who works with children and young people? Has an allegation been made against someone who volunteers with children or young people?

Does it meet the criteria below?

- ◆ Behaved in a way that has harmed, or may harm a child/young persons
- ◆ Possibly committed a criminal offence against or related to a child or young person
- ◆ Behaved towards a child/children in a way that indicates they may pose a risk of harm to children and young people
- ◆ Behaved in a way which indicates they are unsuitable to work with children and young people

The concerns could take place in an individual's work life, community or within their social/home life.
