Project Overview

Tarners is a charity dedicated to running children and young people's services in the Tarners area of Brighton in partnership with the local community. We are based in a community building in Tarners Park where we currently run our children's activities and several youth projects.

The Role

An exciting new opportunity has arisen at Tarners within the busy youth sessions. We are looking for someone with passion to support the young people and staff within sessions. As a Youth Worker, you will support within the sessions with activities, food, young person support and first aid. You will be involved in a briefing and debriefing before and after each session. You may be required to support with planning and consultation with young people.

A key focus for this role is to work closely with other staff, young people, local agencies, funders and service providers, to develop a range of healthy activities for young people of all backgrounds in the Tarners area. To create opportunities for young people, play an active part in planning, organising, and delivering youth projects and support those who choose to participate in that process.

The Ideal Candidate

You will have the ability to engage and build supportive relationships with young people. Ideally, you will have some knowledge of relevant government legislation relating to the Youth Sector and safeguarding. In addition to this you will be passionate, positive and approachable and be able to confidently liaise with local partners and young people.

- Ideally you will have a youth work qualification or relevant experience
- Possess excellent knowledge of Safeguarding
- Good written and verbal communication skills
- Good planning and organisational skills

Working with a local community charity, this opportunity provides the successful candidate a chance to have a significant positive impact on the ongoing high quality provision of youth services. It also offers the chance to work flexibly on a part time basis with a high level of autonomy, whilst working within a small professional team.
